Maui Disaster

For those of us who have been following the news lately, we are aware that the beautiful island of Maui, particularly the Lahaina area, has been devastated by wildfires fueled by high winds. According to a recent release from the governor's office, the death toll now stands at 93 with less than 5% of the area searched. According to press releases by various news agencies, this is the deadliest wildfire to strike the U.S. in over a 100 years! The governor warned that the number of fatalities is expected to rise as the search continues. In addition to the number of deaths, most of the residents of the Lahaina area lost their homes and other property as well. Many of them have been quoted as saying that they have lost everything except their lives.
